Avineon Named a Future 50 Winner by *Washington SmartCEO*

*D.C.-area technology company recognized for its rapid
employee and revenue growth*

ALEXANDRIA, Va. – Jan. 30, 2007 – Avineon, Inc., a successful provider of IT, geospatial, engineering and program management services, announced today it has been selected as one of *Washington SmartCEO's* Future 50 winners for its continuous employee and revenue growth.
